To calculate the Family Employment you will need  
Fact Finder's **Table B23009** from the 2010 Census

## Family Employment

Step 1: Begin at the [American FactFinder main Page](#). In the **State, county or Place** window, enter in your community. Here we are using Stevens Point, Wisconsin
